AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 245 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER ENTITLED LAND USE AND DEVELOPMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 245, Land Use and Development, of the Code of the Township of Manchester: (1) to incorporate minor amendments to Ordinance 11-025 adopted November 28, 2011 by Manchester Township related to cluster lots sizes within the Pinelands PFA-R and PFA-S zones; (2) to establish a special meeting fee in the Township Fee Schedule (§245-12); and (3) Set an expiration date of one (1) year for the issuance of zoning permits.

SECTION 2

Article IV, Zoning, §245-33C(1), PFA-S Pinelands Forest Area Sending, Section C(1)(b)[4][a], is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (b) Single-family residential dwelling units. Clustering of the permitted single-family dwellings shall be required whenever two or more units are proposed as part of a residential development. The following standards shall apply:
 - [1]-[3] No change.
 - [4] Development within the residential cluster shall be designed as follows:
 - [a] Residential lots shall be a minimum of one (1) acre in size within a PFA-S Zone and a minimum of 40,000 square feet within a PFA-R Zone but may be larger if dictated by unusual site conditions. In no case shall the average size of residential lots within a cluster exceed 1.1 acres;

[b]-[e] No change.

[5] No change.

SECTION 3

Article IV, Zoning, §245-33D(1), PFA-R Pinelands Forest Area Receiving, Section §245-32D(1)(b)[4][a], is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (b) Single-family residential dwelling units. Clustering of the permitted single-family dwellings shall be required whenever two or more units are proposed as part of a residential development. The following standards shall apply:
 - [1]-[3] No change.
 - [4] Development within the residential cluster shall be designed as follows:
 - [a] Residential lots shall be a minimum of 44,000 square feet in area, but may be larger if dictated by unusual site conditions except for existing corner lots which shall be 66,000 square feet in area. In no case shall the average size of residential lots within a cluster exceed 49,500 square feet; 1.1 acres;

[b]-[e] No change.

[5] No change.

SECTION 4

Article IV, Zoning, §245-12, Applicant's general submission procedures; fees, is hereby amended to add a "special meeting" fee as follows:

§245-12 Applicant's general submission procedures; fees

All applicants shall comply with the following procedures:

Article IV, Zoning, §245-22, Administration and Enforcement, is hereby amended to add a one (1) year expiration date for zoning permits as follows:

§245-22 Administration and Enforcement

The provisions of this article shall be administered by the Township of Manchester, the Manchester Township Planning Board and/or the Manchester Township Board of Adjustment acting in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:55D-1 et seq.

- A. Ordinance to be administered and enforced by Zoning Officer. The provisions of this Article IV, Zoning, shall be administered and enforced by the Zoning Officer of the Township of Manchester.

A zoning permit shall be issued by the Administrative Officer for the installation of any utilities or for any other land improvements or development which have been previously approved or are contemplated by any approval granted by the Planning Board, Zoning Board of Adjustment or Division of Utilities, whichever case may apply. All zoning permits shall expire one (1) year from the date of issuance.

If any section, subparagraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such decision shall not invalidate any remaining portion of this Ordinance.

Under no circumstances shall more than two vehicles that qualify for parking or storage under this chapter be permitted to be parked or stored on any single residential lot. Any qualifying vehicle over 8000 pounds Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) so parked or stored on any residential lot as outlined in this chapter may not be so parked or stored unless the vehicle is set back no less than 35 feet from any front, back or side property line.



CASH MANAGEMENT PLAN OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

I. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE.

This Cash Management Plan (the "Plan") is prepared pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:5-14 in order to set forth the basis for the deposits ("Deposits") and investment ("Permitted Investments") of certain public funds of the Township, pending the use of such funds for the intended purposes. The Plan is intended to assure that all public funds identified herein are deposited in interest bearing Deposits or otherwise invested in Permitted Investments hereinafter referred to. The intent of the Plan is to provide that the decisions made with regard to the Deposits and the Permitted Investments will be done to insure the safety, the liquidity (regarding its availability for the intended purposes), and the maximum investment return within such limits. The Plan is intended to insure that any Deposit or Permitted Investment matures within the time period that approximates the prospective need for the funds deposited or invested so that there is not a risk to the market value of such Deposits or Permitted Investments.

II. <u>IDENTIFICATION OF FUNDS AND ACCOUNTS TO BE COVERED</u> <u>BY THE PLAN.</u>

A. The Plan is intended to cover the deposit and/or investment of the following funds and accounts of the Township of Manchester.

- 1. Current Fund
- 2. General Capital Fund
- 3. Animal Trust Fund
- 4. Public Assistance Discretionary Fund
- 5. Developer Escrows Funds
- 6. Municipal Alliance Discretionary Fund
- 7. Tax Collectors Trust Fund
- 8. Water Operating Fund
- 9. Water Capital Fund
- 10. Sewer Operating Fund
- 11. Sewer Capital Fund
- 12. General Court Fund
- 13. Public Defenders Trust
- 14. Public Assistance Trust Fund I
- 15. Manchester Day Trust Fund
- 16. Recreation Trust Fund
- 17. Open Space, Recreation, Farmland and Historic Trust
- 18. Water Operating Fund Western Service Area
- 19. Sewer Operating Fund Western Service Area
- 20. Water Capital Western Service Area
- 21. Sewer Capital Western Service Area

- B. It is understood that this Plan is not intended to cover certain funds and accounts of the Township of Manchester, specifically:
 - 1. New Jersey Employment Trust Fund
 - 2. Drug Enforcement Fund
 - 3. Bail Account.

III. DESIGNATION OF OFFICIALS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER AUTHORIZED TO MAKE DEPOSITS AND INVESTMENTS UNDER THE PLAN.

The Chief Financial Officer of the Township of Manchester (the "Designated Official") is hereby authorized and directed to deposit and/or invest the funds referred to in the Plan. Prior to making any such Deposits or any Permitted Investments, such officials of the Township of Manchester are directed to supply to all depositories or any other parties with whom the Deposits or Permitted Investments are made a written copy of this Plan which shall be acknowledged in writing by such parties and a copy of such acknowledgment kept on file with such officials.

IV. DESIGNATION OF DEPOSITORIES.

The following banks and financial institutions are hereby designated as official depositories for the Deposit of all public funds referred to in the Plan, including any Certificates of Deposit which are not otherwise invested in Permitted Investments as provided for in this Plan:

- 1. Wells Fargo
- 2. TD Bank
- 3. Sovereign Bank
- 4. New Jersey Cash Management Plan
- 5. N.J. Asset & Rebate Management Program
- 6. MBIA Municipal Investor's Service Corporation
- 7. Ocean First National Bank
- 8. PNC Bank

All such depositories shall acknowledge in writing receipt of this Plan by sending a copy of such acknowledgment to the Designated Official (s) referred to in Section III above.

V. AUTHORIZED INVESTMENTS.

A. Except as otherwise specifically provided for herein, the Designated Official is hereby authorized to invest the public funds covered by this Plan, to the extent not otherwise held in Deposits, in the following Permitted Investments:

- (1) Bonds or other obligations of the United States of America or obligations guaranteed by the United States of America;
- (2) Government money market mutual funds;
- (3) Any obligation that a federal agency or a federal instrumentality has issued in accordance with an act of Congress, which security has a maturity date not greater than 397 days from the date of purchase, provided that such obligation bears a fixed rate of interest not dependent on any index or other external factor;
- (4) Bonds or other obligations of the Local Unit or bonds or other obligations of school districts of which the Local Unit is a part or within which the school district is located:
- (5) Bonds or other obligations, having a maturity date not more than 397 days from the date of purchase, approved by the Division of Investment of the Department of the Treasury for investment by Local Units;
- (6) Local government investment pools;
- (7) Deposits with the State of New Jersey Cash Management Fund established pursuant to section 1 of P.L. 1977, c. 281 (C.52:18A-90.4); or
- (8) Agreements for the repurchase of fully collateralized securities if:
 - (a) the underlying securities are permitted investments pursuant to paragraphs (1) and (3) of this subsection a;
 - (b) the custody of collateral is transferred to a third party;
 - (c) the maturity of the agreement is not more than 30 days;
 - (d) the underlying securities are purchased through a public depository as defined in section 1 of P.L. 1970, c. 236 (C.17:9-41); and
 - (e) a master repurchase agreement providing for the custody and security of collateral is executed.

For purposes of the above language, the terms "government money market mutual fund" and "local government investment pool" shall have the following definitions:

Government Money Market Mutual Fund. An investment company investment trust:

- (a) which is registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission under the "Investment Company Act of 1940," 15 U.S.C. sec. 80a-1 et seq., and operated in accordance with 17 C.F.R. sec. 270.2a-7.
- (b) the portfolio of which is limited to U.S. Government securities that meet the definition of any eligible security pursuant to 17 C.F.R. sec. 270.2a-7 and repurchase agreements that are collateralized by such U.S. Government securities; and

(c) which has:

- (i) attained the highest ranking or the highest letter and numerical rating of a nationally recognized statistical rating organization; or
- (ii) retained an investment advisor registered or exempt from registration with the Securities and Exchange Commission pursuant to the "Investment Advisors Act of 1940," 15 U.S.C. sec. 80b-1 et seq., with experience investing in U.S. Government securities for at least the most recent past 60 months and with assets under management in excess of \$500 million.

<u>Local Government Investment Pool.</u> An investment pool:

- (a) which is managed in accordance with 17 C.F.R. sec. 270.2a-7;
- (b) which is rated in the highest category by a nationally recognized statistical rating organization;
- (c) which is limited to U.S. Government securities that meet the definition of an eligible security pursuant to 17 C.F.R. sec. 270.2a-7 and repurchase agreements that are collateralized by such U.S. Government securities;
- (d) which is in compliance with rules adopted pursuant to the "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L. 1968, c.410 (c.52:14B-1 et seq.) by the Local Finance Board of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs, which rules shall provide for disclosure and reporting requirements, and other provisions deemed necessary by the board to provide for the safety, liquidity and yield of the investments;
- (e) which does not permit investments in instruments that: are subject to high price volatility with changing market conditions; cannot reasonably be expected, at the time of interest rate adjustment, to have

- a market value that approximates their par value; or utilize an index that does not support a stable net asset value; and
- (f) which purchases and redeems investments directly from the issuer, government money market mutual fund, or the State of New Jersey Cash Management Fund, or through the use of a national or State bank located within this State, or through a broker-dealer which, at the time of purchase or redemption, has been registered continuously for a period of at least two years pursuant to section 9 of P.L. 1967 c. 9 (c.49:3-56) and has at least \$25 million in capital stock (or equivalent capitalization if not a corporation), surplus reserves for contingencies and undivided profits, or through a securities dealer who makes primary markets in U.S. Government securities and reports daily to the Federal Reserve Bank of New York its position in and borrowing on such U.S. Government securities.
- B. Notwithstanding the above authorization, the monies on hand in the following funds and accounts shall be further limited as to maturities or specific investments.

VI. SAFEKEEPING CUSTODY PAYMENT AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RECEIPT OF PLAN.

To the extent that any Deposit or Permitted Investment involves a document or security which is not physically held by the Township of Manchester, then such instrument or security shall be covered by a custodial agreement with an independent third party, which shall be a bank or financial institution in the State of New Jersey. Such institution shall provide for the designation of such investments in the name of the Township of Manchester to assure that there is no unauthorized use of the funds or the Permitted Investments or Deposits. Purchase of any Permitted Investments that involve securities shall be executed by a "delivery versus payment" method to insure that such Permitted Investments are either received by the Township of Manchester or by a third party custodian prior to or upon the release of the Township of Manchester's funds.

To assure that all parties with whom the Township of Manchester deals either by way of Deposits or Permitted Investments are aware of the authority and the limits set forth in this Plan, all such parties shall be supplied with a copy of this Plan in writing and all such parties shall acknowledge the receipt of that Plan in writing, a copy of which shall be on file with the Designated Official (s).

VII. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.

A. In compliance with N.J.S.A. 54:4 73, the collector shall, on the first day of each month report collections to the governing body of the municipality. Additional reports will be provided to the governing body as requested.

- B. On the fifteenth day of each month during which this Plan is in effect, the Designated Official (s) referred to in Section III hereof shall supply to the governing body of the Township of Manchester a written report of any Deposits or Permitted Investments made pursuant to this Plan, which shall include, at a minimum, the following information:
- i. The name of any institution holding funds of the Township of Manchester as a Deposit or a Permitted Investment.
- ii. The amount of securities or Deposits purchased or sold during the immediately preceding month.
 - iii. The class or type of securities purchased or Deposits made.
 - iv. The book value of such Deposits or Permitted Investments.
- v. The earned income on such Deposits or Permitted Investments. To the extent that such amounts are actually earned at maturity, this report shall provide an accrual of such earnings during the immediately preceding month.
 - vi. The fees incurred to undertake such Deposits or Permitted Investments.
- vii. The market value of all Deposits or Permitted Investments as of the end of the immediately preceding month.
- viii. All other information which may be deemed reasonable from time to time by the governing body of the Township of Manchester.

VIII. TERM OF PLAN.

This Plan shall be in effect from July 1, 2012 to December 30, 2012. Attached to this Plan is a resolution of the governing body of the Township of Manchester approving this Plan for such period of time. The Plan may be amended from time to time. To the extent that any amendment is adopted by the Council, the Designated Official is directed to supply copies of the amendments to all of the parties who otherwise have received the copy of the originally approved Plan, which amendment shall be acknowledged in writing in the same manner as the original Plan was so acknowledged.
