

## ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ARTICLE IX DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester in the County of Ocean, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Part I, Chapter 2, Article IX is repealed and replaced with the following:

#### § 2-28. Establishment of Department of Public Safety and Divisions Therein.

There is hereby established a Department of Public Safety for the Township of Manchester, the head of which shall be the Chief of Police. The Chief of Police shall be appointed by the Appropriate Authority - which shall be the Mayor - with the advice and consent of Council. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118, there is hereby established the position of Chief of Police.

Within the Department of Public Safety there are hereby established the following Divisions: The Division of Police, Division of Emergency Services and the Office of Emergency Management.

The Division of Police and the Division of Emergency Services shall each be supervised by Chief of Police or the Chief's designee. The Division of Police shall be referred to as the Manchester Township Police Department.

The Office of Emergency Management is created within the Department of Public Safety and shall be supervised by the Chief of Police or the Chief's designee.

#### § 2-29. Composition of the Divisions.

- A. The Division of Police and the Division of Emergency Services shall consist of one Chief of Police and such offices, rank, members and civilian employees as deemed necessary and appropriate by the Chief of Police in the Chief's discretion with the approval of the Mayor. The Chief of Police, with the approval of the Mayor, may in the Chief's discretion leave one or more of the ranking positions vacant. Whenever such office is left vacant, it will be passed in the chain of command. The Chief of Police, with the approval of the Mayor, may appoint any rank or office that has been vacant by naming a person to fill that rank or office.
- B. Within the Division of Police the following ranks are hereby established: Police Captain, Police Lieutenant, Police Sergeant, Police Patrolman and Police Special Law Enforcement Officer (SLEO).
- C. Within the Division of Emergency Services the following positions are hereby established: Emergency Management Director, Emergency Services Supervisor, Emergency Medical Technician and EMT/Firefighter.

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D. Within the Division of Police, the following maximum numbers of officers authorized at each rank are as follows:

(1) Chief of Police: One.

(2) Police Captain: Two.

(3) Police Lieutenant: Four

(4) Police Sergeant: Sixteen

(5) Police Patrolman: Fifty-Six

(6) Special Law Enforcement Officer: The Maximum Number of Such Positions Authorized by the Township Council.

E. Within the Division of Emergency Services, the maximum number of each position shall be as authorized by Resolution of Council.

#### § 2-30. Duties of Divisions of the Department of Public Safety.

- A. It shall be the responsibility of the Division of Police to preserve the public peace; protect life and property; enforce the laws and regulations of the State of New Jersey and the regulations and ordinances of the Township of Manchester; direct and control traffic; provide protection during emergencies; and provide training and education for the continued efficiency of its members.
- B. It shall be the responsibility of the Division of Emergency Services to provide efficient, professional and expedient emergency care and transportation, as well as supplemental fire response and suppression. The Division of Emergency Services shall also be comprised of those volunteer emergency services agencies designated by the Mayor and recognized by Resolution of the Township Council. The Division of Emergency Services will consist of only of those positions established by Ordinance and those volunteer organizations and entities that are designated by the Mayor and authorized by Resolution of the Council. No other emergency services organizations, including but not limited to those organizations performing fire suppression function and emergency medical operations, are to be formed within the Township without consent of the Council.
- C. The duties of the Office of Emergency Management are conferred by law and as further set forth in this Chapter.

#### § 2-31. Duties of the Chief of Police.

The Chief of Police shall report directly to the Mayor and shall have and exercise the following authority and perform the following duties:



- A. The Chief shall serve as the active administrative and executive officer of the Department of Public Safety and shall command the Department and all those assigned to it. The Chief shall be responsible for the training and discipline of all Department of Public Safety employees.
- B. The Chief shall administer and enforce the Department of Public Safety policies and procedures.
- C. The Chief shall, subject to the approval of the Mayor, establish such bureaus, sections and/or units as may be required for the proper functioning of the Department's work. The Chief shall have the power to assign any and all members of the Department to their respective duties and to require them to perform the same. The Chief shall assign the members of the Department to such duties that in the Chief's judgment shall be in the best interest of the Department and for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Township of Manchester. The Chief may designate members of each respective Division to be in charge of any bureau, sections and/or unit contained within.
- D. The Chief shall exercise and discharge the functions, powers and duties as the Department Head of each Division of the Department of Public Safety.
- E. The Chief shall instruct and direct all of the members of each Division of the Department of Public Safety assigned to active duty with respect to their duties and should require that all duties be performed in a proper and efficient manner.
- F. The Chief shall direct that all policies and procedures be strictly observed and complied with and shall maintain a high degree of proficiency on the part of the Department of Public Safety and its employees.
- G. The Chief shall be the supervisory head of any bureau, sections and/or unit that exists or may be formed within the Department of Public Safety and shall be responsible for its proper operation and may delegate such authority as may be deemed necessary for the efficient operation of the Department.
- H. The Chief shall report at least monthly to the Mayor in such form as may be prescribed on the operation of the Department of Public Safety during the preceding month and make such other reports as may be requested by the Mayor, including but not limited to personnel changes and organizational structure.

#### § 2-32. Duties of Emergency Management Coordinator and Subordinates.

A. Appointment of Coordinator and Deputy Coordinator; terms. The Office of Emergency Management shall be staffed by an Emergency Management Coordinator and a Deputy Emergency Management Coordinator who shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Township Council for a term of three years for the

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Coordinator and one year for the Deputy Coordinator. The Deputy Coordinator will act as the Coordinator in the absence or disability of the Coordinator.

- B. Duties conferred by law. The Emergency Management Coordinator shall be responsible for all duties outlined in <u>N.J.S.A.</u> App.A.:9-40.4 and shall carry out all emergency management operations consistent with <u>N.J.S.A.</u> App.A.9:40.5.
- C. Additional duties and responsibilities.

In addition to the duties conferred by law, the Emergency Management Coordinator, under the direction and supervision of the Chief of Police, shall exercise the following duties and responsibilities:

- (1) Be responsible for the planning, organization and direction of specific emergency management operations within the Township, coordinating the activities of local municipal departments within the Township and providing them with necessary guidance and advise for the development of emergency management programs.
- (2) The coordination of activities of the emergency management staff and to provide definitive information concerning emergency management programs and policies.
- (3) The preparation of budgets, statistical reports, evaluations and other reports as required by the Chief of Police.
- (4) Conduct studies and, when directed by the Chief of Police, make recommended changes to the existing organization and operation to assure continuity between all organizations within the Department of Public Safety.
- (5) Coordinate with the Chief of Police for the overall management and deployment of the auxiliary police during properly declared state or local emergencies or disasters, and during periods of bona fide training in preparation for such occurrences.
- (6) Establish and maintain the Township Emergency Operating Center.
- (7) Develop and conduct drills and exercises for the Township emergency services organizations and practice operations for the municipality in cooperation with county and state emergency management organizations.
- (8) Confer with municipal officials for the development for mutual aid programs, for the planning and organization of emergency management programs and the establishment of a municipal emergency services committee.

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- (9) Provide advice and guidance on emergency management programs and policies, and review plans for conformity with state and county programs.
- (10) Coordinate and utilize municipal emergency management plans for the Township as well as utilization of municipal resources to assure their most effective use.
- (11) Plan and development training programs for the Township staff and assist in the planning and review of the municipal training program for conformity with county and state criteria.
- (12) In emergency situations, coordinate the shifting and mobilization of the municipal emergency services organizations and assist in the processing of requests for emergency aid and the development of aid to the points of greatest need.
- (13) Attend schools, seminars and meetings which enhance the overall emergency management structure of the Township.
- (14) Report to the Chief of Police on all issues concerning the Office of Emergency Management and the Division of Emergency Services.
- (15) Perform such other duties as may be assigned by the Chief of Police or as may be imposed by general law.

#### § 2-33. Special Law Enforcement Officer, Class I, II & III.

- A. There is hereby established in the Township of Manchester the positions of Special Law Enforcement Officer, Class I, II and III.
- B. A Special Law Enforcement Officer is any person appointed to temporarily or intermittently perform duties similar to those performed regularly by members of the Manchester Township Police Division, or to provide assistance to the police force during unusual or emergency circumstances. Special Law Enforcement Officers appointed under the provisions of this subsection shall be those defined as Class I, II and III Officers and shall have those duties and responsibilities authorized by N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.10 and N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146.11.
- C. The number of appointments to Class I, II and III Special Officers shall not be more than 10 officers per class. Said Special Officers shall be permitted to work not more than 20 hours per week with the following exceptions: one Class II officer and all Class III officers shall be permitted to work up to 40 hours per week.
- D. The compensation for Special Law Enforcement Officers shall be established by ordinance of the Township Council.



E. Appointments of Special Law Enforcement Officers will be made in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:14-146-14.

#### § 2-34. Auxiliary Members of the Department of Public Safety.

- A. Establishment of Auxiliary Police Force and Purpose: There is hereby created within the Township of Manchester the Manchester Township Auxiliary Police Force. The purpose of the Auxiliary Police Force is to assist the Department of Public Safety Division of Police in such emergencies and other situations as the Chief may determine.
- B. Establishment of Manchester Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary: There is hereby created within the Township of Manchester the Manchester Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary. The purpose of the Manchester Township Police Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary is to assist the Department of Public Safety Division of Emergency Services by performing such duties as the Chief may determine.
- C. Appointments: Members of the Auxiliary Police Force and Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary shall be appointed by the Mayor, upon the recommendation of the Chief of Police, for a one-year term.
- D. Qualifications: The Chief shall promulgate standards for qualifications of all members of the Auxiliary Police Force and Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary.
- E. Policies and Procedures: All appointed members of the Auxiliary Police Force and Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary will be governed by the same policies and procedures that have been approved by the Chief of Police and promulgated by the Mayor.
- F. Responsibility: All members of the Auxiliary Police Force and Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary shall perform such duties as are designated by the Chief of Police.
- G. Training Course for Auxiliary Police: No person shall be appointed as an Auxiliary Police Officer unless that person has successfully completed a training course as approved by the Chief of Police.
- H. Training Requirements for Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary: No person shall be appointed as a member of the Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary unless such person shall meet minimum training criteria to be established by the Chief of Police.
- Remuneration: No remuneration shall be paid to any member of the Auxiliary Police Force
  or Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary for the performance of duty, monetary or
  otherwise.

#### § 2-35. Police Chaplains.



- A. Establishment of Position: The position of Chaplain of the Manchester Township Police Department be and hereby is established.
- B. Appointment: All Police Chaplains shall be appointed by the Mayor upon recommendation of the Chief of Police. Upon appointment, All Chaplains shall become volunteer members of the Manchester Township Police.
- C. Duties: The duties of the Chaplain shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
  - Be available, if requested, to members of the Manchester Township Police Department, their families and the public in times of need for spiritual counseling.
  - 2. Assist, if requested, with guidance in such areas as ethics, human relations, family life and spiritual priorities.
  - Assist officers and provide counsel, comfort and consolation, if requested, to police personnel and relatives for police-related incidents.
- D. Qualifications: No person shall be appointed as Police Chaplain unless ordained as clergy in good standing in the religious body from which selected.
- E. Terms of Office: All Police Chaplains shall serve as a volunteer, without pay or remuneration. All Police Chaplains, upon appointment, shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.

#### § 2-36. Hiring Qualifications for the Department of Public Safety and Divisions Therein.

No person shall be appointed to any position in the Department of Public Safety, paid or otherwise, who is not qualified as provided for pursuant to the laws of the United States, the Statutes of the State of New Jersey, the New Jersey Administrative Code, the Ordinances of the Township of Manchester and Rules and Regulations promulgated by the Chief of Police.

- A. All applicants seeking employment or volunteer positions within the Department of Public Safety shall complete an application form as prescribed by the Township of Manchester.
- B. No person shall be appointed to any position in the Department of Public Safety who is not a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of New Jersey.
- C. Hiring Qualifications for the Division of Police:
  - Applicants seeking appointment to the Division of Police as a sworn law enforcement
    officer shall submit a fee with the appropriate application form. The fee for such
    application shall be set at a minimum of \$50, but shall not exceed \$100. The fee to be
    charged for applicants seeking appointment to the Division of Police shall be in
    conformance with a Resolution of the Township Council.

Applicants seeking appointment to the Division of Police shall successfully complete
physical, medical and psychological evaluations as determined by the Chief of Police.

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- 3. Applicants seeking appointment to the Division of Police shall possess a minimum of an associate's degree or two years of college credits (64 credits). Credits or degrees must be recognized by the American Council on Education as listed in Accredited Institutions of Postsecondary Education. Active military service may be substituted and/or used in conjunction with college credit for a total of two years of education and/or active military service. Active military service credit will be granted at a rate equivalent to 2.67 college credits for each full month (30 days) of active military service completed.
- 4. Applicants seeking appointment to the Division of Police shall pass a physical, written and/or oral evaluation as determined by the Chief of Police.

#### D. Hiring Qualifications for the Division of Emergency Services:

- Applicants seeking appointment to the Division of Emergency Services shall successfully complete physical, medical and psychological evaluations as determined by the Chief of Police.
- 2. Applicants seeking appointment to the Division of Emergency Services shall successfully complete a skills assessment established by the Chief of Police.
- 3. Applicants seeking appointment to the Division of Emergency Services shall possess such qualifications as determined by the Chief of Police.

#### § 2-37. Appointments to the Department of Public Safety and Divisions Therein.

- A. All initial appointments to sworn positions in the Division of Police shall be by the Mayor for a probationary period of one-year. In the case of initial appointment, the one-year period shall commence at the date of hire or after graduation from a New Jersey State-approved policy academy, whichever is later.
- B. All initial appoints to non-sworn positions in the Department of Public Safety shall be for a probationary period of one year, unless such probationary period is otherwise established in any fully executed agreement between the Township of Manchester and a recognized majority union representative or established within any fully executed individual contract for employment.
- C. All police officers in the Township of Manchester will receive a performance evaluation on a semi-annual basis.
- D. All promotions for any rank within the Division of Police shall be based on competitive standards with testing and performance evaluations to be incorporated into those standards.

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A manual drafted and maintained at the direction of the Chief of Police and approved by the Mayor shall establish those standards.

#### § 2-38. Compensation

The Mayor shall negotiate an employment contract with the Chief of Police subject to ratification by the Township Council.

The compensation of all other employees of the Department of Public Safety shall be in accordance with the Salary Ordinances of the Township of Manchester.

#### § 2-39. Code of Conduct and Discipline

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:14-118, the Mayor is hereby designated as the Appropriate Authority to act under the New Jersey Statutes. Rules and Regulations for the efficient operation of the Department of Public Safety, the government of the Division of Police and the Division of Emergency Services and for the discipline of the members of the Department of Public Safety shall be promulgated by the Mayor approved by the Chief of Police. A copy of any such police rules and regulations shall be provided to all members of the Department of Public Safety. The rules and regulations may be amended at any time by the Chief of Police with approval of the Mayor. Copies of such amendments or additions shall be supplied to all members of the Department of Public Safety. Whenever there is a conflict between the provisions of the rules and regulations of the Department of Public Safety and this chapter, the provision of this chapter shall control. All disciplinary proceedings shall be in a manner consistent with each Division's Rules and Regulations as adopted and ratified by the Township Council.

#### § 2-40. Temporary Off-Duty Employment for Police Officers

- A. Purpose. The purpose of this section is to regulate the temporary off-duty employment for police officers and to establish a rate schedule for such temporary off-duty employment.
- B. Definition. Temporary off-duty assignments include and shall be limited to crowd control, traffic control and security employment where a Manchester Township police officer is required to wear his duty uniform.
- C. Compensation: No police officer shall perform temporary off-duty employment for compensation other than through the procedure established in this section.
- D. Temporary off-duty assignments.
  - Temporary off-duty assignments are duty assignments made by the Chief of Police at the request of private citizens or independent contractors. All extraduty assignments for police personnel shall be approved by the Chief of Police or the Chief's designee. Officers assigned to temporary off-duty employment shall be assigned on a voluntary basis in accordance with the system established

by the Chief of Police or the Chief's designee. The Chief of Police may assign a Township patrol vehicle for use in performing temporary off-duty employment in the event it is determined that the use of a Township patrol vehicle is necessary to perform the contracted duty. The Chief of Police may deny any assignment or use of police officers or vehicles or impose any condition or requirement to the temporary off-duty employment that the Chief determines is in the best interest of the Township or the public safety.

- 2. While officers engaged in temporary off-duty assignments shall be off duty, they shall conform to all Division of Police rules, regulations and procedures. All agreements for temporary off-duty employment shall be contracted for in writing on contract forms available from the Division of Police. All such contracts shall be kept on record with the Division of Police in a place designed by the Chief of Police.
- 3. Compensation for temporary off-duty employment shall be at a rate set from time to time by Resolution of the Township Council. All requests for services from private citizens or independent contractors shall be initiated with a deposit in advance based upon estimates. The Township shall establish an escrow account in a dedicated fund to ensure timely payment to those officers who engage in approved temporary off-duty assignments. Private citizens or independent contractors who require continuous service shall maintain a minimum balance in the established dedicated fund in an amount equal to the average amount paid to the police officers over a monthly time period. If there are insufficient funds, services shall be terminated until the fund is replenished. The Township shall return any moneys in the fund in excess of the cost of services provided to private citizens or independent contractors within a reasonable amount of time. Any private citizen or independent contractor who is delinquent in payment for services rendered in connection with this act shall be liable for costs, fees and attorneys' fees associated with the collection of any amounts due.
- 4. All fees or payments for temporary off-duty assignments shall be made through a special fund established by the Township for which payment shall be made to the individual police officers engaged in such employment. Payments from such fund shall be made to the officer subject to the required deductions and the administrative fee to be retained by the Township.
- Any temporary off-duty employment which is canceled by the private citizen or contractor with less than two hours' notice shall be charged at a four-hour minimum at the rate set by Resolution.
- 6. The Chief of Police has the authority to order any police officer to vacate or terminate any temporary off-duty employment in response to any emergency situation or whenever the employment creates an unreasonable risk to the health, safety and welfare of the officer or the public. The citizen or independent

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contractor shall not be charged for any compensation for any time that the officer is aware from the temporary off-duty employment and may not make a claim for any cost or damages against the Township as a result of the Chief of Police's decision to vacate or terminate any employment under the provisions of this subsection.

7. The Township shall be responsible to provide all the necessary insurance coverages required by law, including but not limited to workers' compensation, public liability and claims for damages for personal injury including death, as well as damage to property which may arise from the temporary off-duty employment performed pursuant thereto.

#### § 2-41. Fees for Emergency Medical Services and Insurance Only Billing

Subject to the limitations provided in this Chapter, fees shall be assessed for emergency medical services provided by the Division of Emergency Services. The fees to assessed for the provision of such services shall be in accordance with a fee schedule to be adopted by Resolution of the Township Council, which shall be amended, updated and supplemented from time to time.

- A. The fees for emergency medical services established by Resolution of the Township Council notwithstanding, when the Division of Emergency Services responds to a call for emergency medical services the Township shall engage in insurance only billing, whereby the Township will accept as payment only what is paid by the patient's health insurance plan, applicable automobile insurance policy, or Medicare/Medicaid.
- B. The Division may utilize other agencies or providers for services, such as but not limited, advanced life support services. Those agencies/providers charge in accordance with their policies and are not subject to insurance only billing, whether billed through the Township or independently to the patient.
- C. The failure of the patient to cooperate in providing necessary information, processing insurance forms, or otherwise refusing to assist the Township in collecting fees owed shall subject the patient to liability to the Township for such services.
- D. The Township may contract with a professional medical billing service for the collection of payment for services rendered by the Division. Said bill shall be issued to the insurance company for the person served or directly to the person served if there is a failure to cooperate.
- E. The Township reserves the right to write-off any bill for Division services rendered to any person.
- F. The Mayor or the Mayor's designee is hereby authorized to enter into contracts on behalf of the Township with various hospitals that provide advanced life support (ALS) services to the patients that are transported by the Division, allowing the hospitals to bundle-bill Medicare for services rendered. Any such contracts shall contain a provision whereby the



hospital will be required to reimburse the Township for its transportation costs, and the Township will be required to pay the hospital all ALS assessments from money each party receives respectively within 45 days of receipt of payment.

SECTION 2: Part I, Chapter 29, Article I is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: Part I, Chapter 68, Article I is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: Part I, Chapter 34, Section 34-1 is hereby repealed and replaced with the

following:

#### § 34-1. Establishment

Fire companies authorized and approved to perform fire suppression services with the Township of Manchester shall be limited to those fire companies that are designated by the Mayor and approved by Resolution of the Township Council. All authorized fire companies shall be designated to be within the Division of Emergency Services and shall adhere to all established rules and regulations pertaining to the Division.

#### § 34-2. Membership

- A. No person shall hereinafter become a member of any authorized Fire Department within the Township of Manchester or any unit thereof, unless above the age of 18, a citizen of the United States, of good moral character and a resident of the County of Ocean.
- B. The person shall be physically fit to perform the duties of a fireman evidenced by a certificate to that effect by a practicing physician of the State of New Jersey, after physical examination for that purpose.
- C. The person shall conform to all requirements for recognition as a member of the Division of Emergency Services.
- D. Every member of the Fire Department shall comply with the Ordinances of Manchester Township and the bylaws of each fire company with whom they become members.
- E. Every person seeking to join any fire company designated to be within the Division of Emergency Services shall make application to the company or unit which the person desires to join. Each person seeking membership shall be obligated to complete any employment forms required by the Chief of Police. Thereafter, upon acceptance of any proposed member by any designated fire company in accordance with that company's rules and regulations, the membership application and all required forms pertaining to the potential member shall be forwarded for review by Chief of Police.



F. Exemption certifications may be issued to members of each volunteer fire company who shall have served seven years in active duty, under municipal control, as required by law.

#### § 34-3. Junior Members

- A. A Junior Firefighters' Program to the volunteer fire departments in the Township of Manchester is hereby established pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A;14-95, et seq. and subject to the supervision of each fire company and each fire company's Chief or Assistant Chief. The members of the program shall be known as Junior Firefighters.
- B. Each volunteer fire company of the Township of Manchester may have a Junior Firefighters' Program.
- C. Junior Firefighters shall meet all of the qualifications of regular firefighters, except that they need only have reached the age of fourteen (14) years and may not have yet reached their eighteenth (18<sup>th</sup>) birthday.
- D. When a Junior Firefighter reaches the age of 18 and wishes to continue as a firefighter in the Township of Manchester, the Junior Firefighter must apply for full membership with a recognized Township of Manchester fire company.
- E. A prospective Junior Firefighter, before being considered for membership as a Junior Firefighter, must obtain permission to join the program from their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) and must submit to the fire company said permission, in writing, and acknowledged or approved in the manner required by law for deeds to real estate to be recorded. Evidence of such permission shall be forwarded to the Chief of Police by the fire company.
- F. Members of the Junior Firefighters' Program shall be insured by the same coverage and in the same amounts provided for regular volunteer firefighters in the Township of Manchester.
- G. Every person seeking to become a Junior Firefighter must apply and be selected in the same manner as regular volunteer firefighters.
- H. Junior Firefighters shall be trained for eventual membership in a recognized volunteer fire department in the Township of Manchester by the Chief or Assistant Chief and the regular members.
- No Junior Firefighter shall be allowed to perform duties that would expose the Junior Firefighter to the same degree of hazard as a regular member of the fire department.
- J. Junior Firefighters shall not fight fires and shall not be required to perform duties which would expose them to the same degree of hazards as a regular active member.



- K. A Junior Firefighter shall wear full turnout gear while riding fire apparatus and performing fire duties.
- L. A Junior Firefighter may deliver such items such as hand lights, exhaust fans, axes and pike poles from the fire apparatus to the regular firefighters fighting fires, but only to those firefighters who are outside of a structure.
- M. At the scene of a fire, a Junior Firefighter may roll hose or help repack hose onto the fire apparatus.
- N. A Junior Firefighter may only ride in the jump seat or cab or the apparatus.
- O. Under the instruction and at the direction of a line officer a Junior Firefighter during drills may perform certain duties such as holding waterlines, ladder work and practice rescue work and pumper operations.
- P. A Junior Firefighter shall assist in keeping the fire apparatus, firehouses and grounds clean.
- Q. Junior Firefighters shall be subject to the provisions of all Township Ordinances relating to the appointment, discipline and discharge of volunteer firefighters and emergency services volunteers.

**SECTION 5.** Part I, Chapter 27, Article I is hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

Chapter 27 Background Investigations and Criminal History Checks

Article I: Background Investigations and Criminal History Checks for Emergency Services / Public Safety Volunteers

#### § 27-1. Background Investigation Required

All persons seeking volunteer positions which in the discretion of the Chief of Police qualify as Emergency Services or Public Safety Volunteer positions are required to submit to a physical examination, background investigation, fingerprinting and to provide a criminal history record as a condition of volunteer employment, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1.4.

For the purposes of this Ordinance, an Emergency Services or Public Safety Volunteer refers to any person who is applying for or performing a public safety task in an unpaid position for a state, county, or municipal criminal justice agency, fire department, or first aid squad. These tasks are defined as public safety functions normally conducted by paid criminal justice agencies, fire departments or first aid squads which are now being



accomplished by unpaid volunteers. This also includes members of the auxiliary police and the Manchester Emergency Medical Services Auxiliary.

#### § 27-3. Consent Required Prior to Performing Investigation

The Township shall conduct a background investigation, criminal history background check and motor vehicle record background check only upon receipt of written consent from the prospective or current volunteer.

#### § 27-4 Fingerprinting

The prospective volunteer shall submit to being fingerprinted in accordance with applicable state and federal laws, rules and regulations, and shall submit sufficient information on forms supplied by the New Jersey State Police.

#### § 27-5. Compliance Required. Refusal to Constitute Automatic Dismissal

Prospective or current volunteers shall submit their name, address, other required information and written consent to the Township for the background investigation, criminal history check and motor vehicle record check to be performed. The prospective or current volunteer shall provide the Township with all reasonable assistance to obtain background documentation and information.

Refusal to submit to a background investigation, criminal history record check, motor vehicle background check and/or physical examination shall constitute an automatic dismissal in prospective volunteer employment or current volunteer employment status.

#### § 27-6. Costs of Investigation

The Township shall bear the costs associated with conducting the background investigation, criminal history background check and motor vehicle background check for all prospective and current volunteers.

Any prospective or current volunteer required to submit to a physical examination as a condition of volunteer employment shall bear the expense of such an examination.

#### § 27-7. Exchange of Data

The Chief of Police of Manchester Township is authorized to exchange fingerprint data and receive criminal history record information from the State Bureau of Identification of the State Police, the Federal Bureau of Investigation or other authorized information providers.

#### § 27-8. Lack of Fitness



Conviction of any crime or offense as described in Title 2C of the New Jersey Code of Criminal Justice, N.J.S.A 2C:1-1, et seq. shall constitute a presumptive lack of fitness as an Emergency Services or Public Safety volunteer in the Township. In any other jurisdiction, conduct which, if committed in New Jersey, would constitute a crime of offense shall constitute presumptive lack of fitness as an Emergency Services or Public Safety volunteer in the Township.

In the event that a review of a current or prospective volunteer's motor vehicle record background check reveals convictions for serious violations of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Code (Title 39), including convictions for Driving While Intoxicated, Refusal to Submit to Chemical Breath Testing, Driving with a Suspended Driver's Privilege, Leaving the Scene of an Accident, or similar violations in this or any other state or jurisdiction, the Chief may restrict or prohibit such prospective or current volunteer from operating a motor vehicle while performing services as an Emergency Services or Public Safety volunteer in the Township. In addition, the Chief may take other action as the Chief may deem appropriate, including directing the current or prospective volunteer to be disqualified from holding Emergency Services or Public Safety volunteer position within the Township.

Convictions of other offenses not contained or described within Title 2C of the New Jersey Code of Criminal Justice may constitute a lack of fitness for any person as an Emergency Services or Public Safety volunteer in the Township. The list of crimes and violations contained in this section is for illustrative purposes only and shall not be construed as a limitation on those criminal activities or violations that would constitute grounds to disqualify, discipline or terminate any volunteer as indicated herein.

Disqualification or removal of any current or prospective Emergency Services or Public Safety volunteer is appropriate when competent evidence other than convictions in the discretion of the Chief of Police would render volunteer service to not be in the interest of public health, safety or welfare.

#### § 27-9. Appeals of Disqualifications

- A. Should the current holder of, or applicant for, an Emergency Services or Public Safety volunteer position be deemed disqualified by the Chief of Police due to the results of a background investigation, criminal history check or motor vehicle background check, an appeal may be filed within 30 days of receiving notice of the disqualification. Any such appeal shall be filed in writing with the Manchester Township Business Administrator. Any appeal which is not timely and appropriately filed shall be deemed a waiver of any current volunteer's or applicant's right to appeal.
- B. Upon notice to the Township Business Administrator of an appeal a Review Committee shall be convened. The Review Committee shall consist of the Mayor, a Council Member, Business Administrator, Chief of Police or the Chief's Designee and the Emergency Management Coordinator.



- C. Any timely and properly filed appeal shall be considered by the Review Committee within 60 days after notice to the Manchester Township Business Administrator. By filing an appeal, any current volunteer or applicant is waiving his or her right to privacy as to the Review Committee.
- D. The Review Committee shall consider all of the circumstances of the proposed disqualification, including all documents which were considered to arrive at the decision to disqualify or terminate the current or prospective volunteer. The appellant may present to the Review Committee any additional factors that the appellant desires.
- E. Upon the conclusion of the hearing before the Review Committee, the Review Committee shall issue a conclusion in writing to the current or prospective volunteer within thirty days. The written determination of the Review Committee is final.

SECTION 6. Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 7. If any Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the Section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**SECTION 8.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon publication in the official newspaper of the Township, as required by and in conformance with law.

REFUNDING BOND ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR THE REFUNDING OF ALL OR A PORTION OF THE TOWNSHIP'S WATER UTILITY BONDS, SERIES 2010A AND SEWER UTILITY BONDS, SERIES 2010B, APPROPRIATING AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$18,500,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$18,500,000 WATER UTILITY REFUNDING BONDS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER FOR FINANCING THE COST THEREOF

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Bond Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:2-1 et seq.), the Township of Manchester, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey (the "Township") has heretofore issued \$15,555,000 aggregate principal amount of its Water Utility Bonds, Series 2010A and \$5,185,000 aggregate principal amount of its Sewer Utility Bonds, Series 2010B, each dated October 14, 2010 (collectively, the "Series 2010 Bonds") providing for the financing of certain water and sewer improvements of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the Township to refund all or a portion of the outstanding Series 2010 Bonds.

Section 1. The Township is hereby authorized (A) to refund all or part of the Series 2010 Bonds (collectively, the "Bonds to Be Refunded"), and (B) to provide for the payment of the costs of issuing the refunding bonds (including printing, advertising, accounting, financial and legal services, and further including bond insurance premium (if any) and underwriting compensation).

Section 2. In order to finance the cost of the purpose described in Section 1 hereof, one or more series of negotiable water utility refunding bonds and sewer utility refunding bonds (collectively, the "Refunding Bonds") are hereby authorized to be issued from time to time in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$18,500,000 pursuant to the Local Bond Law.



Section 3. An aggregate amount not exceeding \$210,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-51(b) has been included in the aggregate principal amount of refunding bonds authorized herein.

Section 4. The purposes for which the Refunding Bonds are to be issued are (i) refunding the Bonds to Be Refunded and (ii) to provide for the payment of the costs of issuing the refunding bonds (including printing, advertising, accounting, financial and legal services, and further including bond insurance premium (if any) and underwriting compensation).

Section 5. Further provisions as to the terms of sale, deposit, securing, regulation, investment, reinvestment, disposition or application of the proceeds of the refunding bonds, and any matters in connection therewith, shall be determined by resolution of the Township Council of the Township adopted prior to the issuance of the refunding bonds.

Section 6. All other matters relating to the refunding bonds shall be performed or determined by subsequent resolution of the Township Council of the Township, or the performance or determination thereof shall be delegated by resolution of the Township Council of the Township to the Chief Financial Officer of the Township.

Section 7. The full faith and credit of the Township are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and the interest on the obligations authorized by this refunding bond ordinance. The obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Township, and the Township shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable real property within the Township for the payment of the obligations and the interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.

Section 8. A certified copy of this refunding bond ordinance as adopted on first reading has been filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey prior to final adoption, together with a complete statement in the form prescribed

by the Director and signed by the chief financial officer of the Township as to the indebtedness to be financed by the issuance of the refunding bonds authorized herein.

This refunding bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law, provided that, except for refunding bonds issued in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:2-51(c), this refunding bond ordinance shall not be effective as to any refunding bonds unless the consent of the Local Finance Board has been endorsed upon a certified copy of this refunding bond ordinance as finally adopted.

- (b) In order to effectuate the Refunding Plan (defined herein), the Chief Financial Officer shall determine the actual principal amount of the Refunding Bonds to be issued; provided that such determination shall be consistent with a refunding bond ordinance finally adopted by the Township Council on December 16, 2019 and entitled, "REFUNDING BOND ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR THE REFUNDING OF ALL OR A PORTION OF THE TOWNSHIP'S WATER UTILITY BONDS, SERIES 2010A AND SEWER UTILITY BONDS, SERIES 2010B, APPROPRIATING AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING \$18,500,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$18,500,000 WATER UTILITY REFUNDING BONDS AND SEWER UTILITY REFUNDING BONDS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER FOR FINANCING THE COST THEREOF" (the

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"Refunding Ordinance"), and be within the parameters set forth in Section 2 of this resolution. The signature of the Chief Financial Officer on the Purchase Contract (as hereinafter defined) authorized in Section 2 hereof shall constitute evidence of the approval of such actual principal amounts.

Section 2. The Refunding Bonds are hereby authorized to be sold to RBC Capital Markets, LLC (the "Underwriter") in accordance with a purchase contract to be entered into by and between the Underwriter and the Township. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to execute and, on behalf of the Township, negotiate a purchase contract substantially in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit A** (the "Purchase Contract") with the Underwriter in the form satisfactory to bond counsel and upon terms satisfactory to the Chief Financial Officer for the sale of the Refunding Bonds to the Underwriter in accordance with the provisions of this resolution, provided that (i) the underwriter's discount shall not exceed \$5.00 per \$1,000 of bonds issued, and (ii) the terms of the sale of the Refunding Bonds and the Refunding Plan (hereinafter defined) are in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:2-51 and N.J.A.C. 5:30-2.5 (which does not require the approval of the New Jersey Local Finance Board, provided the conditions therein are satisfied). The signature of the Chief Financial Officer on the Purchase Contract shall be conclusively presumed to evidence any necessary approvals.

Section 3. (a) The Refunding Bonds shall be issued in the par amounts determined by the Chief Financial Officer to be necessary to (collectively, the "Refunding Plan") pay costs of issuance and to provide a deposit to one or more escrow funds that, when invested, will be sufficient to currently refund all or a portion of the outstanding callable principal amount of the Township's (i) Water Utility Bonds, Series 2010A, dated October 14, 2010, maturing on August 1 in the years 2022, 2025, 2026 through 2028, inclusive, 2031, 2032 through 2038,

inclusive, and 2041 (the "2010A Refunded Bonds") and (ii) Sewer Utility Bonds, Series 2010B, dated October 14, 2010 maturing on August 1 in the years 2022, 2025, 2026 through 2028, inclusive, 2031 and 2032 (the "2010B Refunded Bonds" and together with the 2010A Refunded Bonds, the "Refunded Bonds") and to call the Refunded Bonds for redemption on August 1, 2021 (the "Redemption Date") at a redemption price of 100% of the principal amount of such Refunded Bonds to be redeemed plus any unpaid accrued interest to the Redemption Date. The Refunding Bonds shall mature as set forth in paragraph (f) below.

- (b) The Refunding Bonds shall bear interest at rates, not in excess of five percent (5%) per annum, as agreed to by the Chief Financial Officer as provided in the Purchase Contract, such rates to be set to assure that the Township achieves at least a 3% net present value debt service savings measured against the Refunded Bonds.
- (c) The Refunding Bonds may be subject to redemption prior to their stated maturities as determined by the Chief Financial Officer as part of the sale and as shall be set forth in the Purchase Contract.
- (d) The Refunding Bonds shall be dated their date of delivery or such other later date consistent with the date of sale and shall bear interest at the rates per annum as the Chief Financial Officer shall determine.
- (e) The Refunding Bonds shall be numbered and have such prefix or prefixes as determined necessary by the Chief Financial Officer and be sold and issued with such serial maturities or with such term bond maturities payable from mandatory sinking fund payments made by the Township as determined in the Purchase Contract.
- (f) The Refunding Bonds shall mature on August 1, 2020 (or such other date as shall be determined by the Chief Financial Officer and set forth in the Purchase Contract) and



thereafter on such dates and in the principal amounts as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer and shall bear interest payable semiannually on February 1 and August 1 in each year until maturity commencing August 1, 2020 (or such other dates as shall be determined by the Chief Financial Officer and set forth in the Purchase Contract), at the rates per annum as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer and as set forth in the Purchase Contract.

The Refunding Bonds will be issued in fully registered form. One certificate shall (g) be issued for the aggregate principal amount of Refunding Bonds maturing in each year. Both principal of and interest on the Refunding Bonds will be payable in lawful money of the United States of America.
