REPORTS

Mr. Hudak: Mr. Hudak attended a special Planning Board meeting on January 21st regarding an acute care site plan approval on Route 37. Next Planning Board meeting will be on February 1st. The COVID vaccine has been released and hoped there will be a micro clinic at nursing homes in Manchester.

Mr. Vaccaro: Mr. Vaccaro attended the Pinelands Coordinating Council meeting held via zoom at Bass River Township. Only item on the agenda was PILOT program resolution and the next meeting will be held in the City of Estell Manor. For 2021, he encouraged Council to adopt more energy efficient methods such as solar use, geothermal, electric cars, and charging stations will be needed. Mr. Vaccaro stated that a lot of residents are having issues with obtaining vaccine appointments. He encouraged the Township to establish Covid testing sites, establish Township vaccination sites preferably one on east and west, drive through COVID test sites, and encouraged the Township to hand out PPE. COVID has increased nationwide and cases are increasing in New Jersey and Ocean County, he reminded the public to wear their PPE, wash hands, and continue practicing social distancing. Be safe and monitor your health. After the November General election, where 2.7 million voters voted to approve legalizing marijuana, New Jersey now became the 13th state to legalize marijuana. He again asked and encouraged an ordinance or resolution banning the growth of marijuana and distribution of marijuana in Manchester Township. Mr. Vaccaro thanked everyone for the opportunity to speak

Mr. Fusaro: Mr. Fusaro stated that the Master Plan meetings have been delayed last two months due to COVID and he prefers to have the meeting in person at the building. He suggested that the Zoning Officer offered a number of items in the code to update. Mr. Fusaro suggested that he could prepare one or two items to discuss at the next bi-weekly meeting. He commented on the vaccination program available through the State.

Mr. Wallis: Mr. Wallis stated that it is easy to register online for the vaccine, but it is finding an appointment location is more difficult.

Mrs. Brush: Mrs. Brush stated that she was getting frustrated using the Ocean County website to schedule a vaccine appointment, but she woke up early and was able to get an appointment on February 5th in Voorhees.

Mayor Palmer: Mayor Palmer spoke with Ocean County Health Department Director regarding a plan when they receive more vaccines and when they will open up more vaccination sites. Manchester is high on Ocean County Health Department's priority lists, and hopefully vaccination sites will be set up in senior communities. He stated that there have been an increase in ATV complaints recently, and the police department has an enforcement detail they will be implementing. Mayor Palmer spoke with Verizon and the lack of choices in whiting for cable/tv/internet. Representative from Verizon stated that there are no plans to go into Whiting at this time. He commented on the reappointment of John Ritchie as the Municipal Alliance Coordinator; he cares about the program, and Mayor Palmer appreciates the time John puts into the program.

Mrs. Markulic: No report.

Mr. Buckley: No report.
