AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 21-21

- WHEREAS, on June 28, 2021, the Township of Manchester adopted on second reading Ordinance No. 21-21 amending and supplementing Article 68 (Police Regulations) and Article 245 (Land Use) to prohibit the operation of any class of recreational cannabis business within it Geographical Boundaries; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2 of Ordinance No.21-21 the Township of Manchester amended Chapter 245, subsection 26(b) to now include:
- v. The following uses shall be prohibited with the exception of medically related cannabis distribution, All classes of cannabis establishments or cannabis distributors or cannabis delivery services as said terms are defined in section 3 of P.L. 2021, c 16, but not the delivery of cannabis items and related supplies by a delivery service.
- WHEREAS, the governing body believes subsection v, as adopted and implemented by virtue of Ordinance No. 2021-21 is more appropriately codified in Chapter 245 subsection 25 titled General Regulations.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:
- **SECTION 1.** Chapter, 245, subsection 25 is hereby supplemented and amended by adding the following prohibited uses:
- W. The following uses shall be prohibited with the exception of medically related cannabis distribution. All classes of cannabis establishments or cannabis distributors or cannabis delivery services as said terms are defined in section 3 of P.L. 2021, c 16, but not the delivery of cannabis items and related supplies by a delivery service.
- **SECTION 2.** By virtue of amending Chapter 245, subsection 31, to include the duplicated language of the previously codified Chapter 245, subsection 26(b)(v), the previously codified chapter 245 subsection 26(b)(v), is hereby deleted in its entirety to avoid any issues arising from ambiguity and conflicting interpretations.
- **SECTION 3.** Any article, section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or other provision of the Township of Manchester Township Code inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- SECTION 4. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply



only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 5. A copy of this Ordinance shall be transmitted to the Ocean County Planning Board for filing upon final passage after second reading by the Township Clerk.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and filing with the Ocean County Planning Board, and as otherwise provided for by law.
