Manchester has had the privilege of honoring the nation's veterans by way of tribute and lasting testimonies outside the regular observances of Memorial Day and Veterans Day. In November of 2003 the Township unveiled its "Veterans War Memorial", in July of 2004 "Tuskegee Airmen Park" was dedicated, in April of 2006 "POW/MIA Park" was dedicated and in April of 2010 World War II Memorial Park was dedicated.

In keeping with this tradition, Manchester constructed the "**Honoring All Who Have Served**" Memorial within World War II Veterans Memorial Park to pay tribute to the heroic efforts of our **men** and **women** veterans. The focal point of the monument is a large gazebo with benches installed around the perimeter where those can find a peaceful place to sit and reflect. In addition, carved granite structures behind the gazebo depict scenes honoring Korean War Veterans, Vietnam Veterans, Persian Gulf War Veterans, Iraqi Freedom Veterans and all the Women Veterans.

This project has been funded through voluntary donations from various businesses, veterans and fraternal clubs, non-profit organizations, citizens of Manchester and other communities, and all those who feel this is indeed a fitting tribute.

This year we are offering Veteran Hometown Heroes banners. The cost of the banner is \$100. These banners will be adorned with a photo of the veteran as well as their name, branch of service and years served. The banners will line the walking trails within the park and will be displayed for a full year. At the end of the year, the veteran will be presented with the banner as a keepsake.

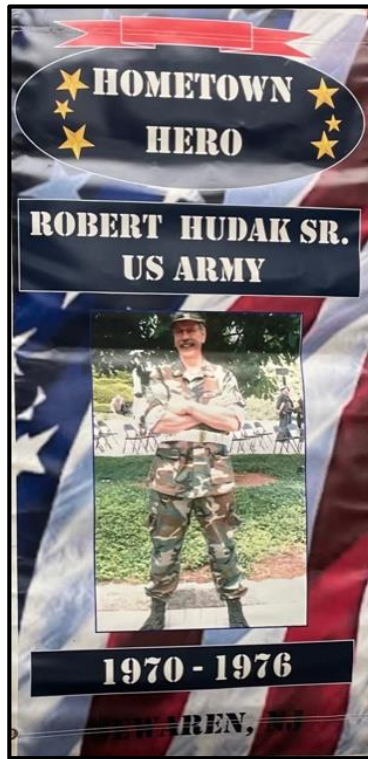
Together with your help and that of many others, we will achieve our goal of producing a fitting and lasting expression of gratitude to these veterans who served our country unconditionally.
