



### **Refund Policy:**

Refunds will <u>NOT</u> be issued once a program starts. Refunds will <u>NOT</u> be issued for one day events, including theatre trips.

Requests for refunds must be made in writing at least 5 business days (Monday through Friday) before a program begins. Written request must include all pertinent information (i.e. – participant name; parent/guardian name; address; phone number; program; reason for requesting a refund).

Full refunds are granted in the event a class is full or cancelled by the Recreation Department. ALL refunds will follow the Finance Department's bill paying schedule and will be issued by township check (no cash refunds). Please allow 4 to 6 weeks for refund to be processed.

The Department of Recreation reserves the right to cancel, change, postpone or change location of any program.
