# AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE VACATION OF PORTIONS OF ROADWAYS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER AT HARRY WRIGHT BOULEVARD, ABUTTING BLOCK 99.235, LOTS 1 & 10

WHEREAS, there exists a right-of-way(s) on Harry Wright Boulevard, abutting Block 99.235, Lots 1 & 10 on the Township of Manchester Tax Map, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Engineer has reviewed the request to vacate portions of Harry Wright Boulevard described in Schedule A, and approves of same; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13(b)(4) authorizes the Township of Manchester Township Council to extinguish and vacate said portions of the street provided that said action is authorized by Ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** There is hereby vacated all of the right, title, and interest of the public for all public usages and purposes in and to those portions of Harry Wright Boulevard abutting Block 99.235, Lots 1 & 10, as is set forth on Schedule A, attached hereto and made a part hereof. The new owners of the vacated property understand that municipal improvements may exist on a portion of the property being vacated. Further, the Township does hereby expressly reserve and except from the vacation all rights and privileges now possessed by public utilities, as defined in R.S. 48:2-13, and by any cable television company, as defined in the "Cable Television Act," P.L. 1972, c. 186, (C. 48:5A-1, *et seq.*), to maintain, repair and replace their existing facilities in, adjacent to, over or under the street, highway, lane, alley, square, place or park, or any part thereof, being vacated by the provisions of this ordinance.

**SECTION 2.** At least one (1) week prior to the time fixed for further consideration for final passage of this ordinance, a copy hereof, together with a notice stating the introduction of the ordinance on first reading and the time and place when and where the ordinance will be considered for final passage, shall be mailed to every person whose lands may be affected by the adoption of the ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be published at least once in an official newspaper of the Township of Manchester at least ten (10) days prior to the time fixed for consideration of the final passage of the ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** The Township Clerk, if this ordinance is adopted on final reading, shall submit a certified copy of this ordinance, together with proof of publication, to the Ocean County Clerk's Office for recording in the Book of Vacations.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect after the second reading and publication as required by law.

**SECTION 6.** A copy of Schedule A as referenced herein shall be kept on file and made available for public inspection in the Township Clerk's Office during normal business hours.

## **SCHEDULE A**

DESCRIPTION OF A PORTION OF HARRY WRIGHT BOULEVARD

MANCHESTER TOWNSHIP, OCEAN COUNTY, NJ BEING VACATED

STARTING along the northeasterly right-of-way of Elizabeth Avenue (60' wide right-of-way) at its intersection with the right-of-way line of Harry Wright Boulevard (100' wide unimproved right-of-way) and travelling in a northeasterly direction for the full right-of-way width of Harry Wright Boulevard approximately 440 feet to the southwesterly-of-way line of Perth Amboy Avenue (60' wide right-of-way).

Effective January 1, 2014, longevity is eliminated for all new employees.

**SECTION 3.** The following positions shall be excluded from the longevity schedule in Section 2 of this Ordinance: Municipal Court Judge, Chief of Police, Township Council and Mayor.

**SECTION 4.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 5.** Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181(b), this Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after its final passage by the Township Council and approval by the Mayor where such approval is required by law.
