# AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 430 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE, ENTITLED "WATER AND SEWER"

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That Section 430-29, entitled "Schedule of Water and Sewer rates for Eastern Service Area," of the Code of the Township of Manchester, be and hereby is amended and supplemented as follows:

## § 430-29. Schedule of Water and Sewer rates for Eastern Service Area

#### B. Connection Fees

- (1) In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:31-11, the initial fees to connect directly or indirectly to the Township's Eastern Ser Area water supply system shall include a connection fee, which shall be set at \$5,451.83 per ESU. In the case of afford housing units, the connection fee shall be 50% per ESU. Connection fees shall be paid at the rate in effect when a build permit is applied for and granted.
- (2) In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:26A-11, the initial fees to connect directly or indirectly to the Township's East Service Area sanitary sewer system shall include a connection fee, which shall be set at \$3,832.55 per ESU. In the cas affordable housing units, the connection fee shall be 50% ESU. Connection fees shall be paid at the rate in effect who building permit is applied for and granted.

- G. Water consumption and sewage collection and treatment charges.
- (1) In addition to the fixed service charges as set forth above, separate water consumption and sewage collection and treatment charges, per 1,000 gallons, shall be paid as follows:

	Water	Sewage
Class I: Residential	\$3.29	None
Class II:	\$3.29	None
Class III:	\$3.29	\$4.33

**SECTION 2.** That Section 430-30, entitled "Schedule of Water and Sewer rates for Western Service Area," of the Code of the Township of Manchester, be and hereby is amended and supplemented as follows:

### § 430-30. Schedule of Water and Sewer rates for Western Service Area

### B. Connection Fees.

(1) In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:31-11, the initial fees to connect directly or indirectly to the Township's Western Service Area water supply system shall include a connection fee, which shall be set at \$3,754.17 per ESU. In

the case of affordable housing units, the connection fee shall be 50% per ESU. Connection fees shall be paid at the rate in effect when a building permit is applied for and granted.

(2) In accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:26A-11, the initial fees to connect directly or indirectly to the Township's Western Service Area sanitary sewer system shall include a connection fee, which shall be set at \$2,374.67 per ESU. In the case of affordable housing units, the connection fee shall be 50% per ESU. Connection fees shall be paid at the rate in effect when a building permit is applied for and granted.

- G. Water consumption and sewage collection and treatment charges.
- (1) In addition to the fixed service charges as set forth above, separate water consumption and sewage collection and treatment charges, per 1,000 gallons, shall be paid as follows:

Residential	\$4.19	None
Commercial	\$4.19	\$2.29

**SECTION 3.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 4.** Following successful adoption of this Ordinance, the provisions herein shall become effective January 1, 2026.
