

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY, PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION OF \$395,000 PROVIDING FOR THE PREPARATION OF A MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53(d) provides that a municipality may adopt an ordinance providing for a special emergency appropriation for the preparation of a master plan or plans when required to conform to the planning laws of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the Township of Manchester, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey (the "Township") has determined to provide for the preparation of a master plan or plans when required to conform to the planning laws of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the preparation of a master plan is \$395,000.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53, the sum of \$395,000 is hereby appropriated for the preparation of a master plan or plans, and the same shall be deemed a special emergency appropriation as defined and provided for in N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55.

Section 2. The portion of the authorization financed shall be provided for in succeeding annual budgets by the inclusion of at least one fifth of the amount authorized by this ordinance and financed and as provided in N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55.

Section 3. A copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and dissemination as required by law.
