



Construction of upgrades and improvements to the Township of Manchester, Route 70 Watermain Extension – ESA, in the amount of \$2,600,000 was financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will extend the water distribution system from Lambeth Lane along Route 70 to the existing water distribution main on Colonial Drive, creating a close loop system, and extending the water distribution to a future water treatment plant in the Township of Manchester.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
