

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANCHESTER, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 359 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE, ENTITLED “SPECIAL EVENTS”, SO AS TO AMEND SECTION 359-22, ENTITLED “STANDARDS FOR PARADE PERMIT ISSUANCE”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 359-22, entitled “Standards for Parade Permit Issuance,” of the Code of the Township of Manchester, is hereby amended, so as to amend subsection D., which shall now read as follows:

§ 359-22. Standards for parade permit issuance.

D. Notice of Issuance.

(1). Immediately upon the issuance of a parade permit, the Municipal Clerk or his/her designee shall send a copy thereof to the following:

- a. The Mayor.
- b. The Clerk's office/Township Council.
- c. The Business Administrator.
- d. The Fire Chief.
- e. The Chief of Police.
- f. Any other necessary department heads the Municipal Clerk or his/her designee shall determine is necessary to notify.

g. A notice of the issuance of the permit shall also be listed on the Township website.

(2). Immediately upon the issuance of a parade permit, the Permittee shall provide notice to each property owner along the route. Notice shall be to each property to notify the affected owners of the date, time and route of the parade.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

NOTICE

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that the foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Township Council of the Township of Manchester, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey on the 27th day of July 2026 and was then read for the first time. The said ordinance will be further considered for final passage by the Township Council in the Town Hall at 6:00 p.m. on August 10, 2026. At such time and place or any time or place to which said meeting may be adjourned, all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard concerning said ordinance.
